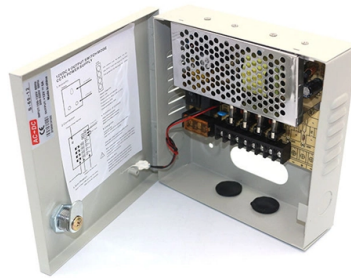


Should a gigabit optical module be connected to a 10-gigabit patch cable

- Port compatibility:** Ensure the switch or device port supports the SFP module. Many 10G SFP+ ports accept 1G SFP modules, but some may lock the port at 1G until configured.
- Distance limitations:** The maximum transmission distance may be shorter than the 10G-rated distance because the module is operating at 1G.
- Performance:** While the connection works, you will not achieve 10G throughput; the link speed is constrained by the module, not the cable.

Recommendation For optimal performance, it is best to use a gigabit-rated fiber patch cable with a 1G SFP module. Using a 10G cable is technically feasible and safe, but it does not increase speed and may be unnecessary unless planning for future upgrades to 10G modules. Always verify ven...
