Multimode pigtails are optimized for short-range connectivity, such as within buildings, data centers, or campus networks, usually operating at $850\ \text{nm}$ or $1300\ \text{nm}$.

Cost and Application Suitability: Single-mode pigtails are generally more expensive due to precise manufacturing and higher-performance transceivers but are essential for future-proofing networks requiring long-distance transmission. Multimode pigtails are more cost-effective for short-distance applications, making them ideal for LANs, enterprise networks, and intra-building connections.

Connector Types and Installation: Both single-mode and multimode pigtails come with common connectors like LC, SC, ST, and FC, with factory-polished ends for low insertion loss and reliable splicing. The choice of connector and polish type (UPC or APC) should match the network equipment and ensure minimal signal reflection.
