

Socket wiring in the distribution box

Sockets in a distribution box are wired via dedicated MCBs, with phase and neutral connected to the respective bus bars, and proper earthing and labeling for safety.

Overview of Distribution Box Wiring

A distribution box (DB) or consumer unit distributes electrical power from the main supply to multiple sub-circuits, including lighting and socket outlets. The main supply enters the DB through a main MCB or double-pole switch, which protects the entire system. From there, power is routed to RCCBs (Residual Current Circuit Breakers) for protection against leakage currents, and then to individual MCBs for each sub-circuit, including sockets.

Wiring Sockets

Sub-Circuit Planning: Each socket outlet circuit is typically protected by a single-pole MCB rated according to the load (commonly 13A or 16A for domestic sockets). Radial circuits are used for sockets, meaning the wiring runs from the DB to each socket in sequence.

Connections in the DB:

- Phase (Live) Wire:** Connect the phase wire from the socket circuit to the output terminal of the corresponding MCB.
- Neutral Wire:** Connect the neutral wire to the neutral bus bar in the DB.
- Earth Wire:** Connect the earth wire to the earth bus bar to ensure proper grounding.

Wiring Direction and Organization: Incoming power from the main breaker is usually on the left side of the DB, while outgoing sub-circuits, including sockets, are on the right. Wires should be neatly bound with plastic ties, maintaining uniform spacing to avoid tangling and ensure safety.

Labeling and Safety: Clearly mark each circuit, indicating whether it is for sockets, lighting, or special appliances. After wiring, perform a safety inspection to check for short circuits, overloads, and proper earthing.

Practical Tips

- Use appropriate wire sizes: For a 13A socket circuit, 2.5mm² copper wire is standard; for 16A, 4mm² may be used depending on local regulations.
- Ensure RCCB rating matches the main MCB to provide effective protection against leakage currents.
- Always turn off the main supply before working inside the DB to prevent electric shock.
