The distribution box prevents that cascade — it receives power from the main supply, divides it into protected branch circuits, and isolates faults before they spread. A feeder usually begins with a feeder breaker at the distribution substation. At this. ACS takes the basic idea of zone wiring and combines it with pre-cut, pre-tested cable and plug-in connectors, to provide power and telecommunication systems that can be installed under raised floors (The Intelligent Floor), or in accessible ceilings (The Intelligent Ceiling).
