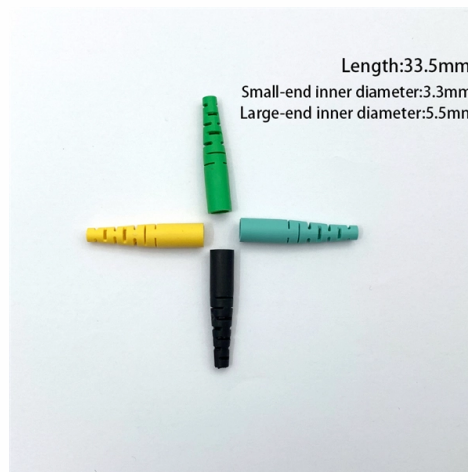

Low IL is critical for maintaining the link budget and supporting high-speed or long-distance transmission . Return Loss quantifies reflected light, which can interfere with sensitive applications. APC connectors are recommended for long-haul or GPON/FTTH networks to minimize back reflection . 3. Connector Types and Polishing Connector types (e.g., LC, SC, MPO) and polish quality (UPC or APC) affect signal consistency. Properly polished connectors reduce microbends and reflections, ensuring stable transmission . 4. Mechanical and Environmental Considerations Patch cords must withstand repeated handling, bending, and temperature changes. Bend-insensitive fibers, aramid (Kevlar) strength members, and LSZH or armored jackets protect the fiber from mechanical...
