- Save Configuration:** Use the command `copy running-config startup-config` on Cisco switches to save the configuration.

- Transceiver Types:** Duplex LC is common for standard SR, LR, and ER modules, while simplex LC is used for BiDi modules.
- Safety:** Avoid direct eye contact with fiber optic lasers and follow proper handling procedures.
