Proper spacing ensures easy access for operation and maintenance. Switch boxes and distribution boxes must be installed in ventilated, dry areas with normal temperatures, avoiding exposure to harmful gases, liquids, or excessive heat. Adequate space should be provided around the boxes to allow two people to work safely, and the area should be free of obstacles, weeds, or shrubs. Construction and Safety Switch boxes are typically made of iron plate or high-quality insulating materials, with metal thickness exceeding 1.5 mm. Electrical components inside should be mounted on metal or non-wood insulating plates and securely fastened. All metal parts, including the box and device plates, must be electrically connected to ensure proper grounding. Wiring inside the switch box should use insulated conductors, with secure joints and no exposed live parts. Neutral lines for operation and maintenance should be separated and connected through terminal blocks.
