Corrosive or high-humidity areas: Aluminum alloy or fiberglass-reinforced plastic trays provide superior resistance.

Tray width and thickness must be selected based on the number, weight, and type of cables, ensuring mechanical strength to prevent deformation under full load. Ladder, ventilated, and solid-bottom trays are chosen depending on heat dissipation, aesthetics, and cable protection requirements.

Installation Guidelines

Support spacing: Typically, supports are installed at intervals recommended by the manufacturer, often 1.5–3 meters for ladder trays, to prevent sagging.

Bend radius: Maintain the minimum bend radius for cables at tray exits to avoid conductor damage.

Cable fill: Do not exceed the allowable fill area; for example, an 18-inch wide tray may have a fill area of 21 square inches, equivalent to multiple conduits.

Flexibility: Cable trays allow cables to enter or exit at any point along the route, reducing the need for additional supports and simplifying modification...
