Resistance Threshold: The total grounding resistance between system parts should be less than 0.1 Ohm to ensure effective fault current dissipation. Best Practices Parallel Grounding Paths: For longer tool cables or multiple spindles, additional grounding wires may be used in parallel to maintain low resistance. For example, a 16 mm² wire from the mounting plate to the spindle plate can reduce total resistance below 100 mOhm. Compliance with International Standards: While local by-laws govern installations, grounding practices in Tonga often align with IEC, IEEE, and AS/NZS standards, which provide guidance on earthing, resistivity, and safety for power systems. Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. On the US market, a 5.26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm² must be used.
