Thorlabs and Glenair also offer buffer strippers and jacket strippers for single-mode and multimode fibers.
- 4. Conduit Access and Cable Entry Tools** Specialized access tools, including cable slitting knives and mid-span access kits, allow technicians to open cable jackets safely and feed fibers into pipes without damaging the core.
- 5. Cleaning and Inspection Tools** After threading, maintaining fiber integrity is critical. Dry action cleaning tools remove dust and residue from fiber ends, while inspection scopes like FiberChek Pro or video borescopes ensure the fiber is clean and properly aligned before termination.
- 6. Termination and Splicing Kits** Fusion splicers (e.g., FSP200) and splice-on connectors allow fibers to be joined or terminated after threading through pipes, minimizing signal loss and ensuring reliable connections.
