Network Topology and Redundancy: Directly connecting two switches is straightforward, but for redundancy, consider running two fiber links and configuring them as a Layer 2 EtherChannel to prevent loops and provide failover .Avoid creating loops without proper spanning tree protocol (STP) configuration.
5. Practical Tips: Verify that both switches support the same port speed and duplex mode. Check the optical power budget to ensure the fiber run is within the supported distance. For multiple switches, consider star or daisy-chain topologies depending on network size and performance requirements . By following these guidelines, two switches can be reliably connected via fiber, supporting high-speed data transfer and future scalability. Proper selection of fiber type, SFP modules, and configuration ensures minimal signal loss and network stability.
