

Underground fiber optic cables are strictly prohibited



Overview

The short answer is no; however, most fiber optic cables are installed underground for protection and reliability. Internet Service Providers (ISPs) often face significant challenges related to Right of Way (ROW) when deploying fiber optic infrastructure or expanding their fiber networks. ROW refers to the legal right to install infrastructure (like fiber optic cables, utility poles, towers, and equipment) on.
