A distribution box (DB box) is an enclosure that safely distributes electrical power from a main supply to multiple branch circuits, protecting circuits with fuses or circuit breakers and organizing wiring for easy maintenance and safety. The terms upward and downward refer to the orientation of the incoming and outgoing cables:

Components

- Main switch or breaker:** Controls the entire electrical supply to the box.
- Circuit breakers or fuses:** Protect individual circuits from overloads and short circuits.
- Busbars:** Conduct and distribute power to multiple outgoing circuits.
- Residual current devices (RCCB/RCBO):** Detect leakage currents and prevent electric shocks.
- Surge protection devices (SPD):** Protect equipment from voltage spikes.
- Earthing connections:** Ensure safety and system stability.

Smart DB boxes may include energy monitoring units and communication modules for real-time data and remote control.
