Fault Location: Activate the red light pen and inject the laser into the fiber. Observe the glowing red light at breaks or bends, which indicates the location of faults. This is especially useful for troubleshooting FTTH installations or long fiber runs.

Calibration and Settings: Many devices allow self-calibration, backlight adjustment, and memory for frequently used wavelengths, improving efficiency in field operations.

Low-Voltage Test Pen for Electrical Circuits A low-voltage test pen (or neon voltage tester) is used to detect the presence of AC voltage in wires, outlets, or switches. It works by allowing a tiny current to flow through a neon lamp or LED when the tip touches a live conductor, causing the pen to glow. To use it safely:

Hold the metal cap or contact point with your hand to complete the circuit.

Touch the tip to the wire or terminal you want to test.

Observe the indicator light; a glow confirms the presence of voltage.

Always remove gloves and avoid high-voltage circuits, as these pens are de...
