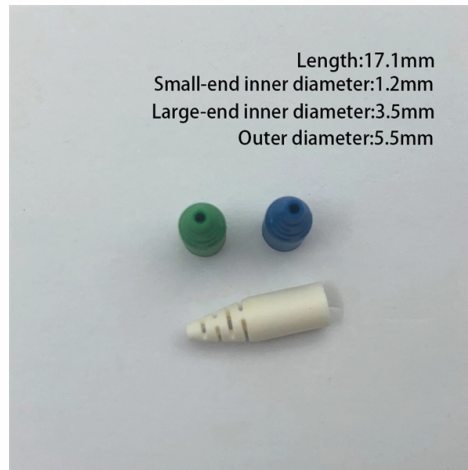


West Africa New Capital Optical Cable Factory
