ST (Straight Tip): Round connector with a bayonet-style twist lock, commonly used in legacy networks and industrial applications. FC (Ferrule Connector): Screw-on type, often used in high-vibration environments and single-mode fiber applications. MTP/MPO (Multi-Fiber Push-On/Pull-Off): Multi-fiber connectors that support high-density cabling, commonly used in data centers for parallel optics and high-speed networks.
