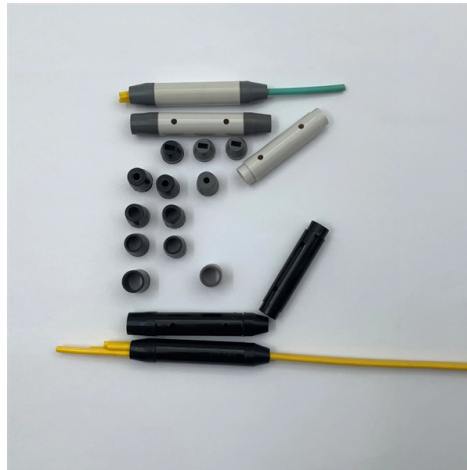


What color looks best for fiber optic patch cords
