Servers In data centers, MPO-MPO patch cords link servers to switches via backbone cabling. When combined with MPO-LC breakout cables, a single MPO trunk can connect to multiple server ports, simplifying cabling and reducing clutter.

Patch Panels and MPO Cassettes MPO patch cords are used to connect MPO trunk cables to patch panels or MPO cassettes, which then break out into LC or SC ports for individual device connections. This structured cabling approach improves manageability and scalability.

High-Performance Computing (HPC) and Optical Distribution Frames (ODFs) MPO-MPO patch cords are also deployed in HPC environments and high-density ODFs, where multiple fibers need to be routed efficiently between racks or cabinets.
