- Outer Sheath:** Provides mechanical protection and environmental resistance, suitable for indoor, outdoor, or industrial applications ().

Types of Optical Fiber Cables

- Single-Mode Fiber (SMF):** Small core ($\sim 9 \mu\text{m}$) Uses laser light Ideal for long-distance communication and high bandwidth ()
- Multimode Fiber (MMF):** Larger core ($50\text{--}62.5 \mu\text{m}$) Uses LED light Suitable for short-distance applications like within buildings or data centers ()
- Plastic Optical Fiber (POF):** Made from plastic Used for consumer electronics and short-range connections ()
