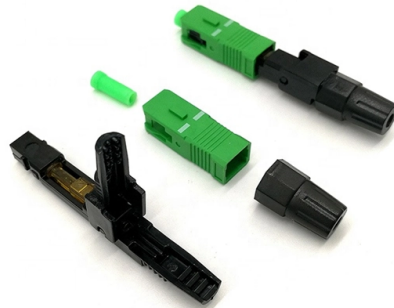


What is the terminal box provided with the broadband
