

What size conduit should be used for a 4-core optical cable



Overview

For such cables, we recommend using at least a 1. It's important to consider not only the rigidity of the jacket but also the breakout point of the assembly, where the strands exit the jacket and are encased in. A 6. 4 mm OD cable has a cross-sectional area of approximately 32. Applying the 40% fill limit ($556 \times 0.4 = 222.4$).
