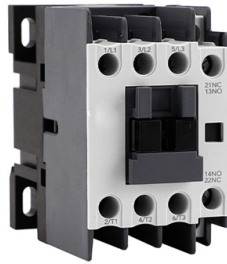


What size should the distribution box cover be

- Type of Breakers** Consider the type of breakers (standard, AFCI, GFCI) as some may require slightly more space. Modular designs can simplify future upgrades.

Practical Tips Always plan for future expansion to avoid replacing the box later. Verify that the cover fits securely and provides full protection against accidental contact with live parts. Ensure compliance with local electrical codes and standards (NEC, IEC, UL/CE certifications).
