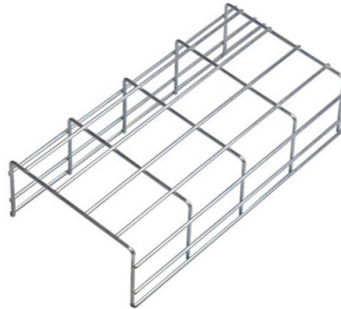

Throughout the late 1970s and early 1980s, fiber optic technology advanced rapidly, with improvements in cladding, single-mode operation, and high-purity glass fibers, enabling longer-distance and higher-bandwidth communication. Submarine and Transatlantic Fiber Optic Cables The first undersea fiber optic cable tested by AT&T Bell Labs was deployed in 1983 in the Atlantic Ocean at a depth of approximately 5 km. The first transatlantic fiber optic cable, TAT-8, was laid in 1988, providing high-capacity communication between the United States, the United Kingdom, and France. This cable represented a major milestone, replacing older coaxial and copper-based transatlantic systems and dramatically increasing data transmission rates. Modern transatlantic cables, such as TAT-14 and Hibernia Atlantic, now use advanced fiber optics with optical amplifiers and self-healing ring topologies, capable of transmitting vast amounts of data with low latency.
