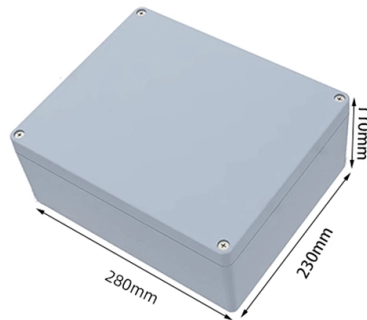

- Select appropriate materials:** For aggressive environments, consider heavy-duty galvanizing (thicker zinc layers), post-fabrication galvanizing, or alternative corrosion-resistant materials like stainless steel or aluminum.
- Environmental assessment:** Conduct a detailed audit of humidity, condensation, and chemical exposure before installation to guide material selection.
