

Wiring Method for Outgoing Lines from Large Distribution Box

Ensure all connections are tight and secure to prevent arcing or overheating. Wire Color Coding and Sizing Phase wires: A phase – yellow, B phase – green, C phase – red Neutral wire: Blue Earth wire: Green/yellow striped Wire gauge should match the circuit load: typically 2.5mm² for lighting and sockets, 4mm² for air conditioning or higher loads.
