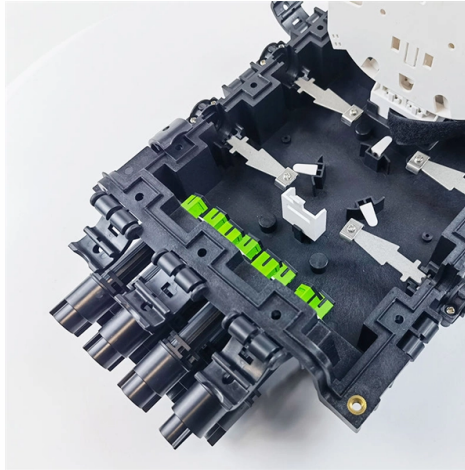


Wiring Techniques for Circuit Breakers in Distribution Boxes

- Branch Breakers:** Connect individual circuits to 1P or 2P breakers depending on single-phase or double-phase requirements.
- 1P Breakers:** Connect one phase line and one load line to the input and output terminals.
- 2P Breakers:** Connect two phase lines and two load lines to the respective terminals.
- Neutral Bus:** Terminate all neutral conductors on the neutral bar, keeping it separate from the ground bar.
- Ground Bus:** Connect all grounding conductors to the PE bar.
- Phase Load Balancing:** For three-phase systems, distribute loads evenly across phases to prevent overheating and voltage imbalance.

Wiring Best Practices

- Line vs Load Identification:** Ensure supply conductors connect to LINE terminals and outgoing circuits to LOAD terminals.
- Wire Sizing:** Match wire gauge to breaker rating and expected load; typical lighting and socket circuits use 2.5mm^2 , while air conditioning may require 4.0mm^2 ...
