

Wiring of Sri Lanka's Secondary Distribution Box

A secondary distribution box in Sri Lanka is wired from the energy meter to a main breaker, followed by circuit breakers, isolators, and RCDs for outgoing circuits, following CEB and PUCSL standards.

Overview A secondary distribution box (also called a sub-distribution board) is an assembly that distributes electricity from the main energy meter to various circuits within a building. It contains protective devices such as a main breaker, circuit breakers (MCBs or MCCBs), isolators, fuses, and Residual Current Devices (RCDs) to ensure safety and compliance with local regulations.

Key Components

- Main Breaker:** Acts as the master switch, isolating the entire system if current exceeds safe limits. It can be a MCCB or MCB.
- Circuit Breakers (MCBs):** Protect individual circuits from overloads and short circuits. They operate automatically when limits are exceeded.
- Isolators:** Provide mechanical isolation for maintenance. They do not operate automatically and must be manually switched.
- Fuses:** Melt to interrupt current in case of overload, providing additional protection.
- Residual Current Device (RCD):** Detects leakage currents and disconnects the circuit to prevent electric shock. A 30mA RCD is recommended for domestic installations.

Wiring Configuration

- Incoming Supply:** The energy meter receives power from the CEB service connection. From the meter, the supply enters the secondary distribution box.
- Main Breaker Connection:** The incoming live and neutral wires are connected to the main breaker.
- Busbars:** Live and neutral busbars distribute power to individual circuit breakers.
- Outgoing Circuits:** Each circuit breaker connects to a specific load (lighting, sockets, or appliances). RCDs are installed where additional protection is required, especially for wet areas.
- Earthing:** Proper earthing is essential. All metallic parts and neutral connections must be bonded to the earth to prevent electric shock.
