

Wiring of circuit breaker in AC distribution box

Proper wiring of circuit breakers involves connecting live, neutral, and earth wires according to breaker type, ensuring safety, balanced loads, and compliance with electrical codes.

Live (L) Wire Connection The incoming live wire, also called the phase or hot wire, should be connected to the line terminal of the circuit breaker. This provides the primary electrical supply to the breaker and ensures overcurrent protection for the circuit it controls.

Neutral (N) Wire Connection

1P (Single-Pole) Breakers: Only the live wire passes through the breaker; the neutral wire bypasses the breaker and connects directly to the neutral busbar in the distribution box.

2P (Double-Pole) Breakers: Both live and neutral wires are connected to the breaker's designated terminals (L and N), allowing simultaneous disconnection when the breaker trips.

Protective Earth (PE) Wire Connection For breakers with residual current protection (RCDs or RCBOs), the protective earth wire must be connected to the breaker's dedicated terminal and linked to the ground busbar. This protects against earth faults and ensures safety.

Installing Circuit Breakers

De-energize the panel by switching off the main breaker and verifying with a non-contact voltage tester.

Mount the breakers on the busbar slots until they click securely.

Connect hot wires to the breaker terminals, ensuring the breaker rating matches the wire gauge (e.g., 15A breaker for 14-gauge wire, 20A for 12-gauge wire).

Connect neutral and ground wires to their respective busbars, keeping wires organized for easy maintenance.

Load Balancing and Safety In single-phase systems, distribute circuits evenly across the two hot legs to prevent overloading. In three-phase systems, balance loads across L1, L2, and L3 to avoid phase imbalance and overheating of the neutral wire.

Use split-load configurations or multiple RCDs to isolate circuits and maintain power...
