Breaker Connections: Connect line wires to the breaker terminals, ensuring tight and secure connections. Each breaker should correspond to a specific circuit.

Neutral and Ground Connections: Attach neutral wires to the neutral bus bar and ground wires to the ground bus bar. Ensure separation of neutral and ground in subpanels if required by code ().

Wire Routing and Management: Route wires neatly along the back panel, using cable ties or clips to prevent tangling and allow airflow for heat dissipation (). Avoid sharp edges that could damage insulation.

Labeling: Clearly label each circuit for future maintenance and troubleshooting ().
